NATURE AND EXTENT OF TRADING MARKET

The shares of the Company have been listed on Nasdaq Europe (formerly EASDAQ) under the symbol "GLGR" since June 23, 1998 and are quoted in Euro. The Company has been listed on Euronext since April 17, 2001 under the symbol "GLOG".

The table sets out the high and low closing mid-prices in Euro for the Company's shares on Nasdaq Europe for each quarter beginning at the time of the Company's initial admission to listing on EASDAQ on June 23, 1998 through to May 17, 2002.

All prices have been adjusted to reflect a five-for-one stock split which occurred on December 15, 1999. In addition, historical per share information prior to January 1, 1999 has been converted from French francs to Euro at a rate of FF 6.55957 to Euro 1.00. The last reported closing mid-price of the Company's ordinary shares on Nasdaq Europe on May 21, 2002 was Euro 4.68 per share.

The average daily trading volume of the Company's ordinary shares on Nasdaq Europe during the year ended December 31, 2001 was 25,232 ordinary shares (single counted.)

company structure

The Company structure as of December 31, 2001 can be found below. It reflects changes made to the organization during the financial year 2001 when Global Graphics aligned its prepress hardware subsidiaries and printing software companies worldwide into two divisions. These changes did not affect Xanalis.

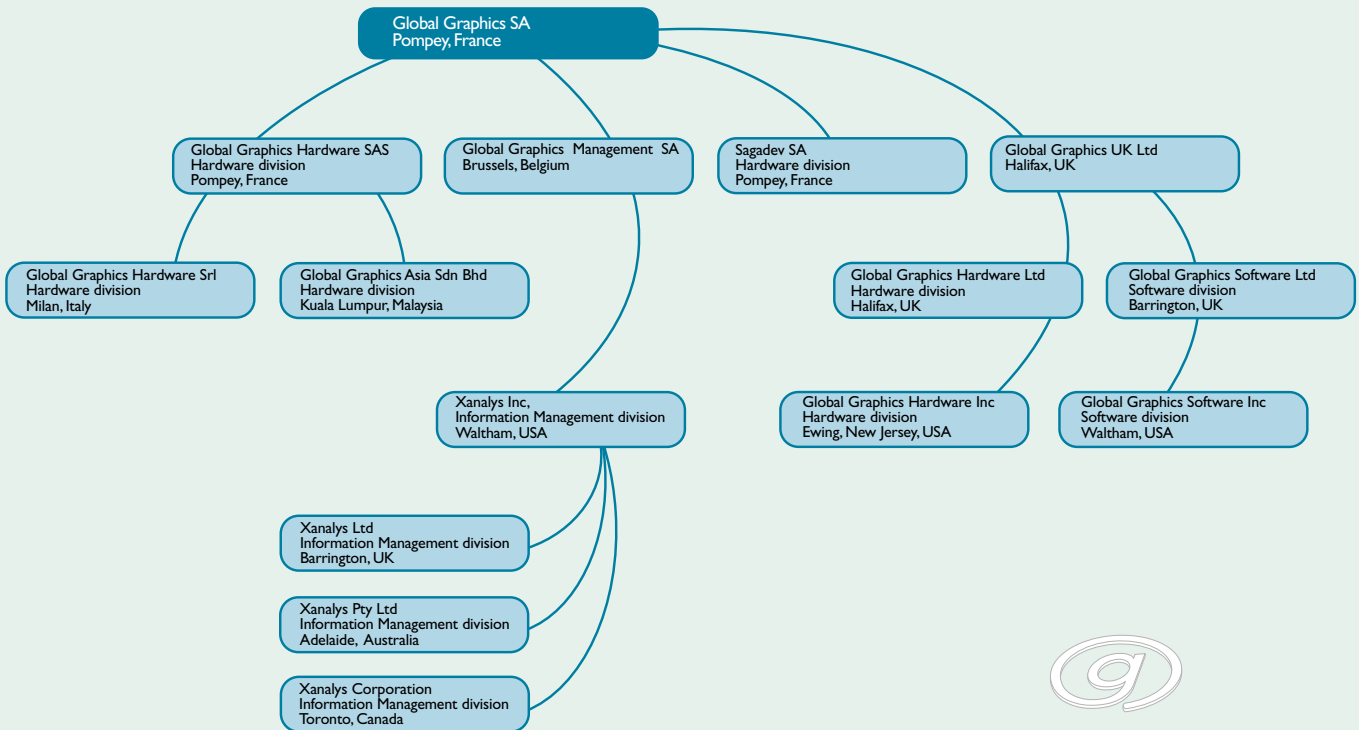
Harlequin Limited was renamed Global Graphics Software Limited after the transfer of all assets and business of Jaws® Systems Limited. Harlequin Incorporated was renamed Global Graphics Software Incorporated.

The hardware businesses in the UK, namely ICG, Heights Technologies and Technigraph were combined to form Global Graphics Hardware Limited. In the United States, Kelleigh, together with ICG's and Technigraph's US operations became Global Graphics Hardware Incorporated. By the end of the year the Hardware division transferred the bulk of its UK production of lithographic plate-processing equipment to the Halifax head office and closed the former Technigraph factory in Thetford (UK).

On October 19, 2001 the Pompey-based Technotol and Tecnolac were sold to a group of local investors. On October 30, 2001, the Colomag assets and business were sold to its original management.
